


# How to Apply to Delta


1. Go to <https://www.deltacollege.edu/>
2. At the top right corner, you will click APPLY



3. You will scroll midway down and click on APPLY FOR ADMISSION



4. You will be redirected to CCCApply where you will create an account



5. Begin creating your account




